## FROM AMSTERDAM SCHIPHOL AIRPORT

### TAXI

There are a number of taxis available at Schiphol airport, to which signs in and around the arrivals area will guide you. The taxis will usually be black or grey, and can be recognized by their (yellow) taxi roof sign and [blue license plate](#).

Should it occur that no taxis are available, the following numbers can be dialed for a direct service:

### Costs and Duration:

The average cost of a single service from Schiphol Airport to The Hague will range from 40 to 65 EUR depending on service and duration.

Average duration of the trip Schiphol Airport to The Hague is approximately 35 minutes without traffic.



## FROM ROTTERDAM-THE HAGUE AIRPORT

### TAXI

Taxis are usually available in front of the Airport Arrivals entrance. Rotterdam – The Hague airport is rather small, which means it is easy as well as fast to get around, but there is also a chance of limited taxis on busy hours.

Should it occur that no taxis are available, the following numbers can be dialed for a direct service:

### Cost and Duration:

The average cost of a single service from Rotterdam – The Hague Airport to The Hague will range from EUR 35 to 45 depending on service and duration. The average duration of the trip from Rotterdam The Hague Airport to The Hague is approximately 20 minutes without traffic.

Exact prices and or bookings can also be found underneath, which is a combined network of most airport taxi companies.

## TRAIN SERVICES TO THE HAGUE

### FROM AMSTERDAM SCHIPHOL AIRPORT

There is a direct line between Schiphol and The Hague, which runs 4 times per hour without transits. The journey takes approximately 35 minutes in total. If you have a train with 1 transit, this will be in Leiden CS and the train to The Hague will leave on the opposite track. Please pay attention to the fact that there is also a direct connection between Schiphol and The Hague Holland Spoor. Not to be confused with The Hague Central Station.

### FROM ROTTERDAM – THE HAGUE AIRPORT

Using public transport from Rotterdam to The Hague is not recommended with luggage, as there is some walking involved getting from the airport to transit station. Should you wish to choose public transport, an airport shuttle bus will take you from Rotterdam Airport to the nearest above ground metro stop called 'Meijersplein' (Operated by RandstadRail) which will take you directly to The Hague Central Station.

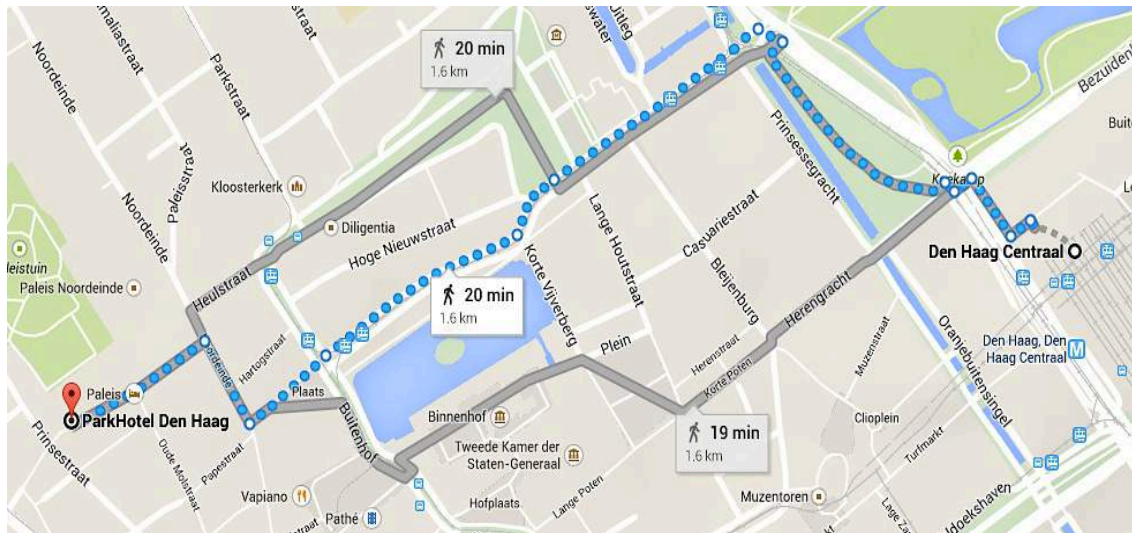
### Cost & Duration

## GETTING TO THE PARK HOTEL

### FROM THE HAGUE CENTRAL STATION TO THE PARK HOTEL



The Park Hotel can easily be reached by foot, which takes about 20 minutes.

By tram: you can take any of the numbers underneath which run every 5 minutes and will take you to the 'Buitenhof' stop in approximately 12 minutes where you will find the Dutch parliament to your left.
